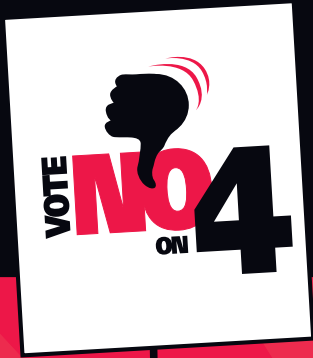


Free Event – Everyone Welcome – Show Your Support of "Vote No on 4"
